

Easy Crochet Chunky Cowl

Super simple and very quick cowl for winter weather.

What you'll Need: -

- \circ 1no. 100g ball of Women's Institute Soft & Chunky Yarn (Exclusive to Hobbycraft)
- 1no. 6mm crochet hook
- Scissors

Stitch Abbreviations: -

Ch = Chain Stitch

Tr = Treble Stitch

Sl st = Slip stitch

Crab stitch = rdc (reversed double crochet) worked backwards in reverse direction to the rest of the hat.

 $\underline{Foundation}$. Ch 62. SI st into 1^{st} ch to make a large loop. Make sure your chain isn't twisted.

<u>Row 1 - 12</u>. Ch3 [counts as first tr]. 1tr in each stitch along. SI st to 3^{rd} ch of 3ch tr. [62tr]

<u>Top Edge</u>. Ch1. Crab stitch in each st around – Working from left to right around the top of the cowl. SI st into the 1st (last) st. Tie off & Weave in end. [62rdcs]

<u>Bottom Edge</u>. Join your yarn to any stitch on the bottom of your cowl. Repeat Top Edge. [62rdcs]
