- Crochet Designs -

Easy Crochet Wreath Decoration

What you'll need...

- Curtain Ring
- Green DK Yarn
- Red and Gold ribbon
- Red beads
- Sparkly embroidery Floss
- 3.5mm Crochet hook
- Scissors & Sewing Needle

Stitch Abbreviations...

Ch = Chain stitch

Sl st = Slip stitch

Dc = double crochet

Tr = Treble crochet



Step 1

Tie your green yarn in a knot to the left of the hook on the curtain ring. Start to work dc stitches around anti-clockwise gently pushing the stitches together every now and again.

Work dc stitches all the way around until you can't fit anymore on, then sl st into the 1st st.

Step 2

Chain 3, dc into a st about 3 stitches along. Repeat all the way around working loops evenly around until you have 15 3ch loops evenly spread around the ring. Sl st into top st.

Work 5tr into next 3ch loop, dc into next 3ch loop. Repeat around until there are 8 5tr shells. Sl st into top st then tie off. Tie both ends (Starting end and finishing end together at the back of the wreath – cut off and weave in ends)

Step 3

Weave red ribbon (or any coloured ribbon that matches your Christmas Tree) in and out of the 3ch loops all the way around and tie ends in a bow at the top.

Step 4

Tie gold ribbon (Or silver/any colour) through the hook on the curtain ring to make a loop to hang your decoration on the tree.

Step 5

Take sparkly embroidery floss and beads and work evenly around the front of the wreath for extra sparkling detail that will stand out on the Christmas tree.
