## Bob the Blood Blob Crochet Pattern

### You will need:

50g of Red Acrylic DK yarn  
50g Hi-Loft Polyester Soft Toy Filling  
3mm Crochet hook  
2no. 5mm black safety eyes  
Tapestry Needle  
Stitch Marker

### Measurements:

10cm Width x 15cm Height



This pattern is written in UK Crochet Terminology.

### Abbreviations:

**Dc** = Double Crochet (sc/Single crochet in US Terminology)

**St** = stitch

**Inc** = 2 dc into the same stitch

**Dec** = dc2tog (yarn through st, yrh (yarn round hook) and draw a loop through st, yarn through next st, yrh and draw a loop through st. Yrh and pull through all 3 loops on hook.

### Pattern Notes:

This pattern is worked in the amigurumi method - working dc stitches in a spiral (there is no slip stitch to close each round). Use a stitch marker to mark the first stitch of each round so you know where you're up to. Work dc sts into FLO (front loops only). This helps the back loops to seal the gaps between stitches and stop stuffing from escaping the plush. (You know you're doing it right when ridged stripes appear on the inside of your work). The number in squared brackets is the number of stitches you should have at the end of the round. Repeat stitch combinations between \*\* by the amount stated.

**Round 1:** Magic circle, 6 dc. [6 sts]

**Round 2:** dc into each st. [6 sts]

**Round 3:** \*2 dc, inc\* x 2. [8 sts]

**Round 4:** dc into each st. [8 sts]

**Round 5:** \*3 dc, inc\* x 2. [10 sts]

**Round 6:** \*4 dc, inc\* x 2. [12 sts]

**Round 7:** \*3 dc, inc\* x 3. [15 sts]

**Round 8:** dc into each st. [15 sts]

**Round 9:** 14 dc, inc. [16 sts]

**Round 10:** \*7 dc, inc\* x 2. [18 sts]



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- Round 11:** \*5 dc, inc\* x 3. [21 sts]  
**Round 12:** \*6 dc, inc\* x 3. [24 sts]  
**Round 13:** \*5 dc, inc\* x 4. [28 sts]  
**Round 14:** dc into each st. [28 sts]  
**Round 15:** \*13 dc, inc\* x 2. [30 sts]  
**Round 16:** \*9 dc, inc\* x 3. [33 sts]  
**Round 17:** \*10 dc, inc\* x 3. [36 sts]  
**Round 18:** dc into each st. [36 sts]  
**Round 19:** \*5 dc, inc\* x 6. [42 sts]  
**Round 20:** \*6 dc, inc\* x 6. [48 sts]  
**Round 21:** \*5 dc, inc\* x 8. [56 sts]  
**Round 22:** \*6 dc, inc\* x 8. [64 sts]  
**Rounds 23 – 27:** dc into each st. [64 sts]  
**Round 28:** \*6 dc, dec\* x 8. [56 sts]  
**Rounds 29 – 30:** dc into each st. [56 sts]

Place safety eyes between rows 23 & 24 8 sts apart (6 sts between each eye)

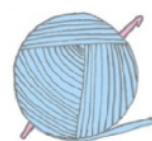
- Round 31:** \*5 dc, dec\* x 8. [48 sts]  
**Round 32:** \*6 dc, dec\* x 6. [42 sts]  
**Round 33:** dc into each st. [42 sts]  
**Round 34:** \*5 dc, dec\* x 6. [36 sts]  
**Round 35:** \*4 dc, dec\* x 6. [30 sts]  
**Round 36:** \*3 dc, dec\* x 6. [24 sts]  
**Round 37:** \*2 dc, dec\* x 6. [18 sts]

Stuff Bob the Blood Blob with toy filling, making sure to get it into the top where the stitches are tighter.

- Round 38:** \*1 dc, dec\* x 6. [12 sts]  
**Round 39:** dec x 6. [6 sts]

Tie off, leaving a tail of 15 cm.

Using a tapestry needle, weave the tail around the 6 sts and pull tight. Push the needle through the bottom of the blob all the way up to the top, and out the other side. Cut off the tail that comes through the toy (so the tail is hidden inside the stuffing).



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
